The mission of DC Kids is to partner with and empower families in making disciples of the youngest Jesus seekers in our church and community. We serve children birth through 6th grade and strive to offer secure, interactive, age-appropriate classes and activities that help children understand who God is and how they can relate to Him. For security, if this is your first Sunday here, please make sure to stop by the Children's Check In Desk where a volunteer can help you fill out a temporary guardian receipt and nametag sticker(s) for your child(ren). You can also find information on how to set up a profile in our KidCheck security system so that you can check your child(ren) in and out more easily each time you attend. All children are required to have a sticker, and all children 4th grade and under must be picked up by a parent or guardian with a guardian receipt. 5th and 6th grade students are released on their own at the end of class.

On Sunday mornings, we offer a range of options for children to worship and learn, depending on age:

- For infants under 2 years, we provide a professionally staffed nursery during worship and class time, 9:45 AM-Noon. Babies old enough to sit without help will participate in a short, developmentally appropriate Bible lesson during this time.
- For 2 year-olds, we offer a self-contained classroom that opens immediately following communion and remains open through the end of adult Bible classes at noon.
- For 3-5 year olds, we provide "Creation Kingdom" a class with rotations through specialized hands-on activities. Children in the this age group are dismissed immediately following communion along with the 2-year-olds and stay in Creation Kingdom through the end of adult Bible classes at noon.
- For elementary aged children, 1st grade through 6th grade, we offer age-appropriate Bible classes during the adult Bible class time after the conclusion of the worship service. Currently, students are grouped together in the following age groups: 1st/2nd together; 3rd/4th together; and 5th/6th together.

The DC Kids ministry also offers a few tools to help children participate and even lead in worship. Except on special event Sundays, we will usually have a KIDS LISTENING GUIDE for children to use to help them listen and participate in all parts of the worship service. These can be turned in after class to a volunteer at the children's check in desk for a prize. Look for these guides at the tables outside the auditorium. And, on 5th Sundays, all our children age 3 and up participate in student-led Children's Worship in the PowerHouse room. 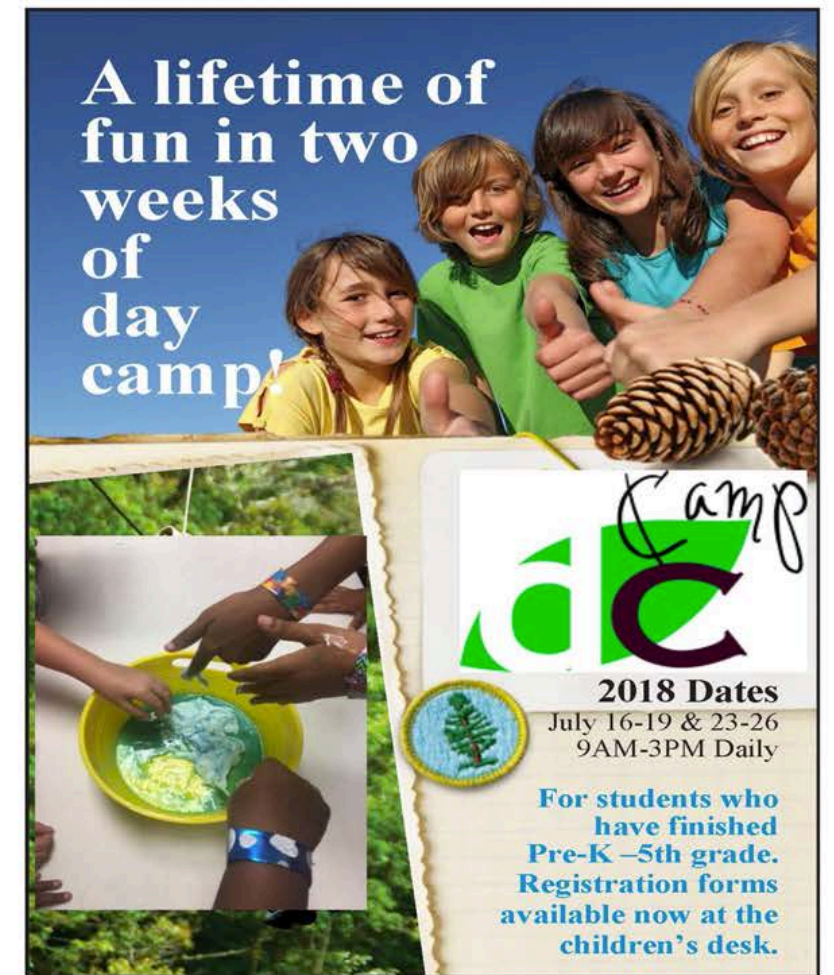
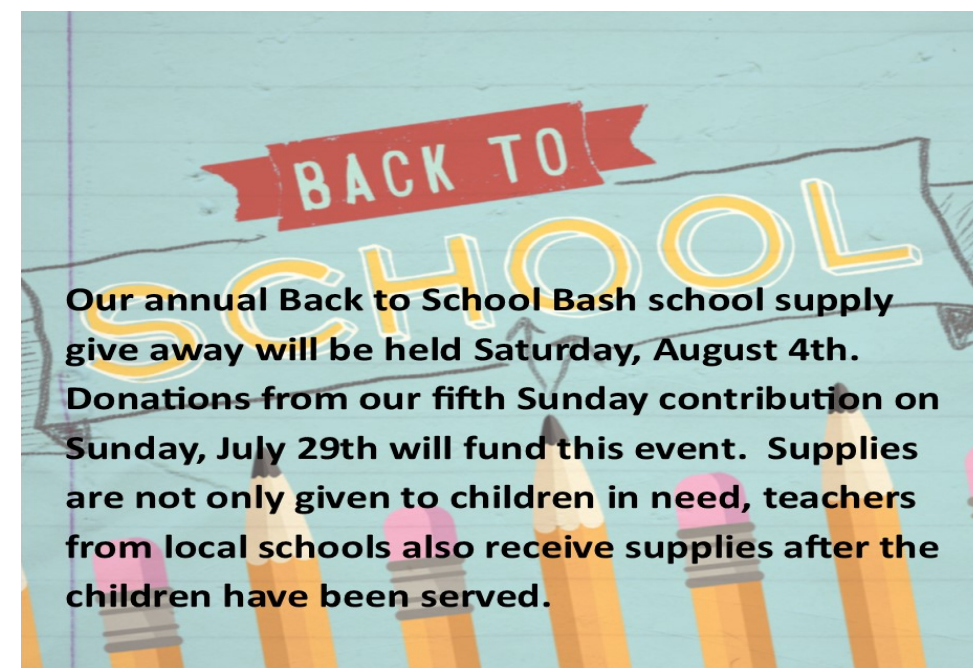
