### Creation Kingdom Parents

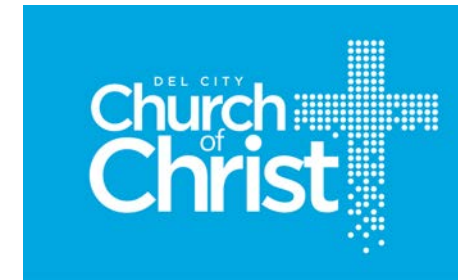
