MESSAGE NOTES: "Therefore"

Romans 12:1 "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship."

Paul is shifting the focus of his letter by appealing to the reader.

"to present your bodies as a living sacrifice"

There is nothing more costly , but no one more worthy.

Holy: To be set apart, to be pure, without flaw.

Acceptable to God: To be pleasing to God. One that stands out for it's excellence and catches God's attention.

Psalms 19:14 " Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, My Rock and My Redeemer."

Romans 12:2 "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect."

1. Do not be conformed: Mindset that is self focused

2. Be transformed: Have a complete change more than just mindset

3. Renewal: Be completely transformed to the mind before corruption

"So that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect."

It is hard for us discern what the will of God is until we practice these 3.

What could be God's Will?

Romans 12:3-8

Romans 12:9-21
