

Revival

If you look closely at the Bible story, what becomes abundantly clear is that God's people are constantly in the need of revival. We get fired up for God, level out, decline in our interest, and then need revival in order to get fired up again. There is nothing new under the sun.

The same thing happened to the Sardis church of Christ. Thus we read in Revelation 3:2, *"Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die."* Revival is necessary to prevent spiritual death. Four areas need a revival in most every church.

The first is **involvement**. Involvement prevents dissolution. Show me a member who is uninvolved and I will show you a member who is about to dissolve his relationship with Jesus and His church. Too often people think Christianity is something you spectate, something you do by appointment. Christianity is something you **are!** It is a daily walk and relationship with the Lord and His people. And you cannot be right with the Lord without being involved with His people. His church is His avenue of ministry to the world. A living church will be a church full of involved members who don't have to be begged to participate. Instead, involved members will challenge leadership to expand the work even more.

Secondly, **commitment** needs to be revived. When commitment is not there, involvement suffers. Jesus expects 100% from His people. He wants you to be at least as committed to Him as you want your spouse to be to you.

The third revival needed is in the area of **faith**. God calls us to walk by faith and not by sight. Small faith is a testimony to the world that you serve a small God. I know none of us would want to be guilty of saying God is small. But when we operate with what we can only see clearly in mind, that's exactly what we are saying. "We never did it that way before" is a sad commentary to a small faith.

The fourth area in which we must be revived is **vision**. How's your vision? Do you have any vision, any dreams for God? The dreams you have for your ministry for God are the natural resources for your life. They are the spring from which flow all the creative ways we imagine for accomplishing His purposes. Solomon once said, "Where there is no vision, the people perish" (Proverbs 29:18). We must dream big with big faith for our big God. Then we will begin to once again see numerical and spiritual growth in His church.

The time is now for great revival at the Del City church! The time is now for great revival in you.
