

Sounds Like Jesus

“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in Heaven” (Matthew 5:14-16).

I would just like to say that this past Wednesday evening the Del City Church was into some serious light shining. I want to personally commend everyone who was able to show up and participate in one of our three Mid-Week Ministry opportunities. I won't be naming names, because that would shine the glory on us individually instead of the Father in Heaven. But I am so proud of you all!

Eighteen folks went to the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma and helped box up 4,100 pounds of food into 180 individual boxes that will be distributed to 180 Oklahoma families in need of food. That will provide 3,416 meals for folks who would otherwise go hungry. Sounds like something Jesus would do.

Fourteen people went to Elmer and Wanda Cochran's home to tackle yard work that has been too much for them to manage with Elmer's current health struggles. They mowed grass, pulled weeds, trimmed hedges, drained dirty pool water, cleared vines and underbrush. The ages of the workers ranged from teenager to 85. What an incredible outpouring of love! Sounds like something Jesus would do.

Thursday thru Friday of this past week was the annual Garage Sale Fundraiser that benefits Camp Rock Creek. In addition to many who have been preparing for this sale for several days prior to Wednesday, thirty-one folks showed up Wednesday night to help get the setup finalized. The proceeds of this garage sale will help mould and shape young lives into the image of Jesus through the great work done at Camp Rock Creek. Sounds like something Jesus would do!

This is what church looks like. This is what being the hands and feet of Jesus means. This is why we are saved by grace through faith, *“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them”* (Ephesians 2:10). Keep sounding like Jesus!
