Sometimes things are too broken to fix. So we throw it away and replace. But what do you do when it is your heart? How do you fix a broken heart. From this I Am statement of Jesus, notice three factors involved in fixing a broken heart.

  - C. The only C\_\_\_\_\_ for a broken heart is our own B\_\_\_\_\_.
  - D. A C\_\_\_\_\_ heart is our gift to God; a new heart filled with C\_\_\_\_\_ and hope is His gift to us.
