

Ministry & Maintenance Report 2021

1. You gave \$679,791.43 averaging \$13,072.91 weekly.
2. 14 precious souls were baptized into Jesus Christ.
3. Over 30 new folks placed membership.
4. From June through December, Community Cupboard Ministry served 292 families (329 adults, 202 children) averaging 42 families per month.
5. Meals-On-Wheels served at least 2,250 meals.
6. Resumed Ministries in full force: Football Team Meals, Community Cup, VBS, Camp Rock Creek, Day Camp, Whiz Kids, Fall Festival, Ladies Bible Study, Wednesday Night Meals, Mission Sunday.
7. Summer Nights of Service did yard work, fed homeless and aided the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma.
8. Garden Ministry grew and distributed tons of food and provided countless hours of community service.
9. Christmas Store Ministry served 42 families and 202 children.
10. We hired ministry staff who have worked tirelessly with our children, teens, congregational and evangelistic outreach.
11. We added four godly men to our group of Shepherds.
12. We supported 18 different mission works.
13. We supported Children's Homes with \$10,200.
14. We made repairs and updates to the campus.

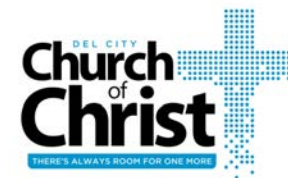
