

Make It Your Business To Care

The year always starts with good intentions. Church leaders make plans: for growth, for soul winning, to build, to improve, to involve, etc. Members make plans: to do better than ever, to win one soul for Jesus, to give, to cooperate, get involved, etc. Somewhere during the year following those good intentions a lot of folks stumble between the planning and doing. An attitude springs up which says, "They were going to do this. They were going to do that." It should be us, not they. This "they" attitude is rooted in apathy. We can begin to just not care.

In C. S. Lewis' book, *The Screwtape Letters*, he imagines that the devil has a nephew named Wormwood. He portrays the devil teaching Wormwood all the subtleties and techniques of tempting people. "The goal," he counsels, "is not wickedness but indifference." Satan cautions his nephew to keep the prospect comfortable at all costs. If he should ever become concerned about anything of importance, encourage him to think about his lunch plans and not to worry because it could cause indigestion. And then he gives Wormwood this job description: "I, the devil, will always see to it that there are bad people. Your job, my dear Wormwood, is to provide me with people who don't care."

If Satan can cause the body of Christ to be apathetic when it comes to fulfilling its planned work, he knows nothing will get done. We each one must make it our business to care. We need not wait until asked to do a job. If you see a job which needs doing, make it your business to inform the elders (you don't need permission!), then get the job done. When you hear of plans and activities which need assistance, don't wait for an "arm twisting" contest. Volunteer! Make it your business!

Once upon a time there were four men named Everybody, Somebody, Anybody and Nobody. There was an important job to be done and Everybody was asked to do it. But Everybody was sure that Somebody would do it. Anybody could have done it. But Nobody did it. Somebody got angry about it because it was Everybody's job. Everybody thought that Anybody could do it, and Nobody realized that Everybody wouldn't do it. It ended up that Everybody blamed Somebody and Nobody did the job that Anybody could have done in the first place!

The work is currently going well at Del City. But there is always room for improvement. It will do even better if you will make it your business to care, and get involved.

Cleaning Supply Drive

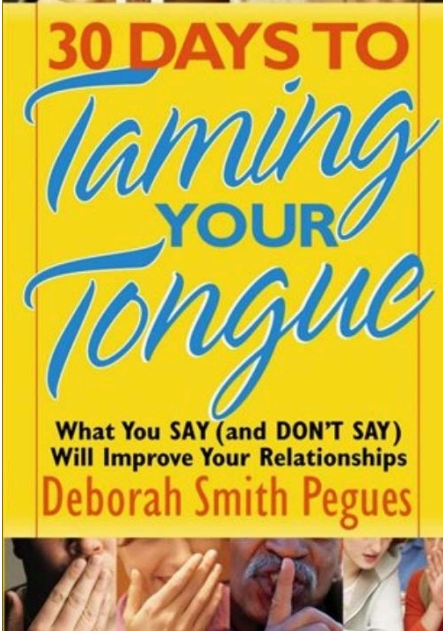
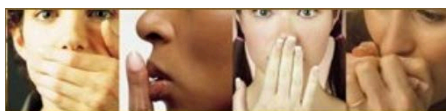
