Don't Worry; Just Be Ready

Prophets of Doom: "The end is near!" This cry has been heard throughout the land for centuries. People have worried. They have cried. They have proselyted. And still we remain.

A religious group in America predicted the end would come and the Lord would appear in 1914. 1914 came and went. "1925," said they. A slight miscalculation. Then it was 1941. No, make that 1945. Wait, how about 1975. I think they finally gave up trying to predict the end. Today most of them deny the predictions were ever made in the first place. But they were made. And they were false.

Others have tried and failed. Some have even decided *how* it would happen. Nuclear holocaust. Famine. Cooked to death by the sun due to a deteriorated ozone layer. A few years ago a theory said we will be destroyed by an object the size of the moon hurtling through space at 20,000 miles per hour, due to enter our solar system in 1991. Doctor Decker Frie was the bearer of this bad news. Based on Luke 21:25, some speculated this to be one of the signs Jesus said would indicate that the end is near. It didn't happen, as you can tell, because we are all still here. Some have speculated the continuing crises in the Middle East or Ukraine are going to facilitate the end through war. Tornados, earthquakes, hurricanes, polar ice melting, corrupt governments, wars and rumors of wars are all seized by the doomsayers to add credibility to their claims. So we worry. And fret. And speculate.

In the first century, some of the Christians in Thessalonica were having similar difficulties. Apparently some had even stopped working. They must have thought, "If Jesus is coming any minute now, what's the use in working?" So Paul charged them to get back to work (1 Thessalonians 4:11). Then he said, "But as to the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need to have anything written to you. For you yourselves know well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night...So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober" (1 Thessalonians 5:1-2, 6). Paul is saying, "Look, no one knows when the Lord is coming back. There will be no forewarning. A thief doesn't send a telegram or an email before he strikes. And neither will God before He comes. So don't worry about it, just always be ready!"

Sounds like good advice to me. Speculations are meaningless. They just cause arguments and distract us from our main mission for Jesus. Worry is useless. Like a rocking chair, it gives you something to do, but you never get anywhere. Fretting is counter-productive and simply wears you down. So don't worry, just be ready! Jesus may come tomorrow. He may come in fifty years. Or He may delay another thousand years. It doesn't matter; just be ready. If you die first, it may be tomorrow. Or it may be in fifty years. Just be ready.

Readiness. That's the bottom line. Are you ready to die? Have you been put into Jesus through repentance and baptism? Are you ready for Jesus to come? Study the Bible for your answers. Don't rely on the wisdom and speculations of men. They want you to worry. God simply wants you to be ready.
