## SERMON NOTES

### Victorious Living: Take Your Mountain! Joshua 14, 15

Caleb was one of God's great men. Courageously at the age of 85 he said to Joshua, "Give me this mountain Moses promised to me!" Obstacles didn't scare Caleb and they shouldn't scare us either. We need to channel Caleb's spirit and zest for life if we want to enjoy victorious living. There are four great characteristics in Caleb's life we must also possess.

- I. **C\_\_\_\_\_ (Joshua 14:8-9, 14).**
  - A. Every ounce, every inch, every nerve and every F\_\_\_\_\_ of Caleb B\_\_\_\_\_ to God.
  - B. "You are not your own, for you were B\_\_\_\_\_ with a P\_\_\_\_\_" (1 Corinthians 6:19-20).

## EDITORIAL

### Just Another Fairy Tale?

It seems to be the American way to cloud reality with fairy tales. And, to a degree, I suppose that is okay. Fairy tales are fun. They are entertaining. They spark the imaginations of the young and the young at heart. They make fascinating movies. But they are still fairy tales.

There is a danger in *Fairy Tale Land*: NOT BEING ABLE TO DISCERN FAIRY TALES FROM REALITY. This was first brought to my attention a number of years ago by a child who had just discovered the fairy tale nature of many of the holiday characters such as Frosty and Rudolph. He was trying to get it all sorted out. He finally asked, "Well, is Jesus just another fairy tale?" Now that's a question that will make your heart stop! You see, the characters of fairy tales are the subjects of many amazing stories. They are portrayed in pictures, immortalized in movies. They are imitated by people dressed in costumes, but you never really see the real thing. So when this young man discovered the fairy tale nature of his favorite holiday characters, it was natural for him to assume that Jesus was just another fairy tale, too.

I wonder how many people in our society have grown up with a fairy tale image of Jesus? In just a few days our society is going to stop and celebrate a holiday called *Christmas*. To most people, the main characters of this holiday will be fairy tales. And somehow *they* are given equal emphasis with *Jesus Christ*. I want us to realize, especially our children, that Jesus Christ is not just another fairy tale. He is for real!

I fully realize that because there is no command in the Bible stating we should celebrate the birth of Jesus, typically many of us do not usually choose to emphasize His birth at this time of year. In fact, it is very likely He was born sometime in the Spring. The Bible clearly ignores the actual date of His birth. Historically, churches of Christ have even been judgmental toward other religious groups for celebrating Christmas as the birth of Christ, viewing it as something not authorized by the Scriptures. Personally, I believe that point of view is a bit reactionary and unnecessary. Why would anyone have heartburn over acknowledging the birth of the King of Kings and Lord of Lords? The Scriptures clearly teach that if someone wants to consider one day more sacred than another in honor of the Lord, then let him do it without condemnation (Romans 14:5-8). This is one of those areas of personal freedom a disciple has the right to exercise.

Here is my point: rather than condemning and correcting folks for thinking December 25 is Christ's birthday, wouldn't it be more productive to take advantage of the possibility that they may be thinking about Christ at all? Dispel the myths for sure. Make sure Jesus does not get confused with "just another fairy tale." Then help folks understand why Jesus was born in the first place.
